2020 National Merit Scholar Semifinalists

In 2018, over 1.5 million high school juniors in more than 21,000 schools entered the National Merit Scholarship Program by taking the Preliminary SAT (PSAT). The nationwide pool of Semifinalists, representing less than one percent of US high school seniors, includes the highest scoring entrants in each state. The PSAT/NMSQT Selection Index score include critical read + mathematics + writing skills. In Illinois, students who earned a score of 221 or greater qualified as Semifinalists.

To become a finalist, Semifinalists must submit a detailed scholarship application. From the approximately 16,000 Semifinalists nationwide, about 15,000 are expected to advance to the Finalists level, and they were notified of this designation in February 2019. All National Merit Scholar designees are selected on the basis of their skills, accomplishments, and potential for success in rigorous college studies, without regard to gender, race, ethnic origin, or religious preference.
